PROPOSALS

2889 Title Change of Radiological Technician 2 (9915) and abolishment of Radiological Technician 1 (9918)

Upon on discussion of this proposal, an error was found in the summary for the title of this series. The Board modified the summary of this proposal to correct the title from Radiological Technician to Radiological Technologist. Upon modification of the summary, a motion of Jay Arceneaux, seconded by Kymberly Gillespie, the SPB approved changing the title of Radiological Technologist 2 and abolishing Radiological Technologist 1. This proposal is effective May 23, 2020.

2890 DOP – Revise the Workplace Security policy (DOP-P15)

Upon motion of Forrest Roles, seconded by Rick Wallace, the SPB approved revision of the *Workplace Security* policy to comply with amendments to W. Va. Code § 61-6-19 and § 61-7-2 from the passage of Senate Bill 46 in the 2020 Regular Session of the Legislature. This policy amendment is effective May 11, 2020.
