


### NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code § 29-6-10(2), a public hearing on amendments to the pay plan for classified employees will be held by the West Virginia State Personnel Board on Thursday, June 23, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. in Building 3, first floor Conference Room 124, of the State Capitol Complex, 1900 Kanawha Boulevard, East, Charleston, West Virginia. A call-in number will be available on the agenda which will be posted on the Division of Personnel website.

The public hearing will consider the following amendments to the pay plan, which are set forth in the proposed salary schedule:

- (1) the revision to the West Virginia Division of Personnel Schedule of Salary Grades to replace the current minimum, market, and maximum rates of pay grades 2 through 26 by ten percent (10%); and,
- (2) a plan of implementation providing that:
  - an incumbent whose salary falls below the minimum rate of the new compensation range shall have his or her salary adjusted to the new minimum;
  - an incumbent whose salary falls within the new range shall maintain his or her current salary. Few employees will be impacted as their salaries will not be lower than the new range;
  - an incumbent whose salary falls above the maximum rate of the new range shall maintain his or her current salary; and,
- (3) move the Nurse Practitioner (9602) and Physician Assistant (9640) classifications to pay grade 81 in the Physician and Allied Health Executives pay schedule.

Oral comments will be accepted at the public hearing.
